

# Health Policies

Your child's safety is our top priority. We ask that all health concerns, allergies, or special needs be clearly noted during registration so we can plan accordingly.

## Medication Policy

Camp staff are allowed to administer medication to campers **ONLY if a detailed permission and dosage letter** has been presented to the Director. This includes both prescription and over-the-counter medications such as cough syrup, allergy relief, or pain relievers.



Thank you for partnering with us to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all staff and campers.



However parents are free to administer directly medication during camp hours. Arrangements must be made in advance.

If campers are unwell, we kindly ask that they remain at home.

# Safety Policies

- All campers must be signed in and out by a parent, guardian, or authorized adult.
- Campers will only be released to individuals listed on the registration form.
- No loitering on the camp compound
- The use of illegal substances will not be permitted near or around the campers and camp environment.
- Inform camp director of any changes in persons to collect campers
  
- For safety reasons, glass bottles, glass food containers, and glass lunch boxes are not permitted at camp.
- Please send food and drinks in durable, non-breakable containers such as plastic or stainless steel.
- Campers encouraged to wear comfortable enclosed that protects their feet: sneakers, enclosed sandals, or Crocs with the back strap secured.



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
